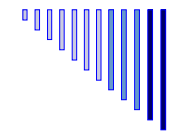

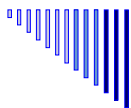

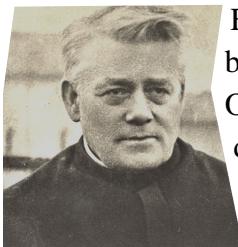

Father Jordan



Fr. Francis Jordan was born in Germany in 1848. On his travels Jordan was deeply touched by the religious and moral privation of the people and was determined to become a priest. His dream was to have all people, men and women, religious and lay, join together to spread the Gospel to the whole world. His vision was ahead of his time, but he was given permission to found a religious order of men, the Society of the Divine Savior and later, an order of women, the Congregation of the Sisters of the Divine Savior. It wasn't until the 1960's when Vatican Council II called all religious orders to return to the charism of their founders that Father Jordan's dream was fulfilled and the Lay Salvatorians were established and the Salvatorian Family as Jordan envisioned it became a reality.
